2007-Quilt Retreat

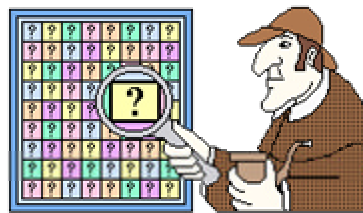

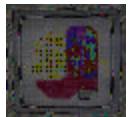


Pillow Talk

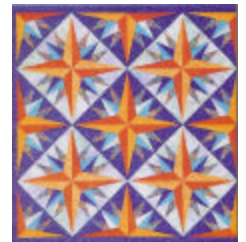


Paper Piece the Quick -Strip Way

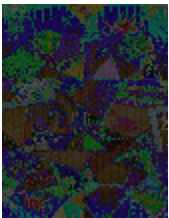


Crazy Quilting, Revisited
