Knitting with Fabric Class

Knitting with fabric is a really fun new technique. In class you can choose to make a beautiful scarf, shawl, poncho or purse. Using a Shape Cut Plus Template, cutting your strips to make your "Fabric Yarn" is really quick. If you're a little rusty or a beginner don't worry we'll show you how to cast on, knit and end your project by casting off. (2 week class)

Bargello Quilt

So many quilts. . . So many fabrics. . . So little time. Maybe these are some reasons for learning the fast quilt-as-you-build-it construction (a strip pieced method) to make a beautiful bargello lap quilt. Bargello has long been known as a type of needlepoint embroidery, Bargello quilting imitate this needlework tradition. (4 week class)

It can't be simpler than this! Nancy uses ONLY squares and rectangles (no diamond shapes or Y-seams) to make 8-pointed stars, Lone stars and more. We'll make a quilt using the basic eight-pointed star & a square-within-a-square block. You can use beautiful floral or a cute kids print to make this quilt. (4 week class)
