Piecework or appliqué — or a little of both. Watch your quilt grow row upon row. Pattern by: With Needle and Thread 12 month program : finished size: 90" x 111" Cost: \$16.00 per month for kit (kit price includes the fabric, patterns, & accessories for finishing the quilt top & binding).



Back to Nature — 2nd Sat. of each month 1:30-3:30

Starts January 16th

Monthly enjoy the beauties of nature creating this wonderful queen size quilt. Flying geese, log cabin and zigzag geese picture frame the block, finishing the quilt with a beautiful border print. (Instructions and add on kits will be available for a King size) Pattern by: Wing & a Prayer Design, LLC 11 month program; Finished Size 96" x 106"

Cost: \$22.00 per month for kit (kit price includes the fabric, patterns for finishing the quilt top, backing & binding).

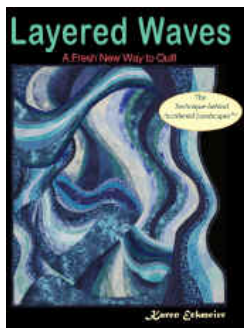
Table Runner / Wall Quilts (Pockets) 3rd Fri. of each month 10:30 am-4 pm

Make a small wall quilt or table topper for each month of the year. Size approx 20" x 30". Kits contain fabrics for top, backing and binding. Come join us for one or all 12 months.

Basic Quilt Blocks

Learn to construct the common units used to piece quilt blocks. This is a good class for the newer quilter as well as those more advanced. Each of the 6 classes will focus on one block – attend one class or attend them all. Make a few of the featured blocks for a small quilt (approx. 35" square), make more blocks for a larger quilt, or collect one or two from each session to create a sampler quilt. You should be comfortable with rotary cutting, 1/4" seam allowances, quilting and binding before taking this class. We suggest taking "Kindergarten Quilting" (Nov 2) first if you are a new quilter.
